73	23-Sep-08	France	Novalac	Novalac AR Digest	Novalac ordered the withdrawal of a batch of powdered baby milk sold in pharmacies after salmonella traces were found in eight babies. The batch in question consists of about 4,500 cartons filled with boxes of powdered milk, expiry date of June 18, 2011.
72	23-Sep-08	China	Sanlu	Sanlu	Milk already contaminated with melamine also found to contain <i>Enterobacter sakazakii</i> . No new recalls, but recorded here as a matter of interest.
71	12-Sep-08	Botswana	Tiger	Purity	Purity Formula Stage 1 and Stage 2 (400 & 600gm cans) with extended shelf life stickers recalled in Botswana, which forbids change of expiry dates on products.
70	12-Sep-08	China	Sanlu (+ 22 others)	Sanlu	Sanlu recalled 700 tons of baby formula after contamination with melamine. The Ministry of Health recalled a further 8,000 tons. Over 6,000 babies ill; 150 in critical condition; four babies died as of 19-9-08. Sanlu formula was also seized in Taiwan and Yemen. 22 other companies were also found to have mixed melamine into milk.
69	27-Aug-08	Spain	Sanutri	Natur 1, Confort 1, Confort 2	Products confiscated by the Ministry of Health after 29 infants suffered diarrhoea between Feb-July 08 from formula contaminated with <i>Salmonella enterica</i> serotype Kedougou. Confiscated were: Natur 1 (lots 708641 and 800052); Confort 1 (lots 708311 and 801141); Confort 2 (lot 708321).
68	12-Mar-08	South Africa	Nestlé	Lactogen 1	Infant formula manufactured in South Africa, batch no 73100179 L1, Nov. 6 and distributed in South Africa, Botswana and Zambia recalled after a mixing error led it to contain excessive levels of copper, iron and zinc.

57	28-Apr-07	Greece	Rhea	Poupy	<p>This product poses a serious risk of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- choking because the handle of the pacifier can detach by applying low force, become accessible and completely fits into the small parts cylinder;</li> <li>- suffocation because the cord of the pacifiers is longer than allowed by the relevant standard.</li> </ul> <p>Taking into account the usual behaviour of children, the detachable handle poses a risk of choking, while the too long cord poses a risk of strangulation to children under 3 years. The product does not comply with the relevant European standard EN 71-1.</p>
